

## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS

Trafford Handball Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its participants. The provider believes that it is important that participants, leaders, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the provider should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, participants are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the provider the club's Welfare Officer.

As a member of Trafford Handball Club you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All players must participate within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- Respect the spirit of fair play in handball. This is more than playing within the rules. It also incorporates the concepts of friendship, respect for others and always participating with the right spirit.
- All participants must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Participants should keep to agreed timings for sessions / activities.
- Participants must wear suitable clothing – indoor trainers, suitable clothing/kit– for sessions, training and match sessions, as agreed with the session leader/coach.
- Take personal responsibility to ensure that they are suitably insured for their activities
- Participants must pay fees for sessions or events promptly.
- Participants are not allowed to smoke on the provider's premises or whilst representing the provider.
- Participants are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the provider premises or whilst representing the provider.
